## **Principal's Report**

Welcome back to Term 4. It has been wonderful to see many smiling, happy children and refreshed teachers throughout our school! Term 4 is a busy time of learning and with summative assessments, reports, excursions, Kinderlinks, Yr 2-3 and 6-7 Orientation and all of the end-of-year celebratory and graduation events. We look forward to our students' continuing learning journey and growth.

#### TIME TO LEARN

At the end of last term, we reflected on our core business of learning and teaching and what we could adjust to maximise the learning for students in the classroom each day. We listened to the students, staff and parents in regards to the impacts on what deep learning, and the answer was clear...time. This term we are trialling an adjustment of school organisational processes to give greater learning time in the classroom for all students. This will mean every classroom program will have enough time to effectively teach all of the outcomes in each of the Key Learning Areas as outlined by NESA.

Learning time begins at 9:15am. The students will line up at their classes designated area at the beginning of the day and end of break times. All students who arrive at school after this time need to be signed into the office by a parent.

There will not be any line-up assemblies. Formal assemblies will occur in the hall each fortnight. K-2 assemblies are scheduled for the even weeks of the term and 3-6 assemblies are scheduled for the odd weeks of the term.

In making this small adjustment we have increased the effective learning time by more than 2 hours each week. Thank you to the students and staff for maximizing learning each and every day.

Participating in the survey is entirely voluntary; however, your responses are very much appreciated, to ensure the data is reliable. To this date we have received 11 responses from our community.


We would love to have a response from every family so that the survey is truly representative of our school community, and I urge you to set aside some time to provide current feedback to the school.

#### Intention to Apply For Year 7 Entry to a Selective High School In 2020

Selective high schools cater for high achieving academically gifted students who may otherwise be without sufficient classmates at their own academic and social level. These schools help gifted and talented students to learn by grouping them with other gifted and talented students, teaching them in specialised ways and providing educational materials at the appropriate level.

Applications for selective high school placement are considered mainly based on the Selective High School Placement Test results and school assessment scores. The Selective High School Placement Test will be held on:

### Thursday 14 March 2019.

If you would like to have your child considered for Year 7 selective high school entry in 2020, you will need to apply via the internet using a valid email address (not the student's email address).

The application website opens at that link on **9 October 2018** and closes on **12 November 2018**. You must apply before the closing date.

Please note that it is also necessary to bring your child's Birth Certificate or identity documents, copies of any family law or other relevant court orders, your child's immunisation history statement and four documents for proof of residence (please contact the school office for the documents required).


#### Sandpit Photos Family Portrait Day is BACK!
